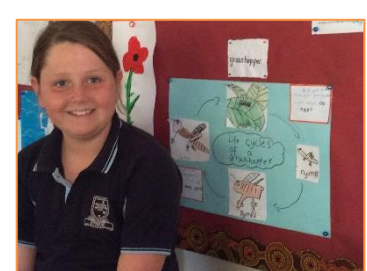
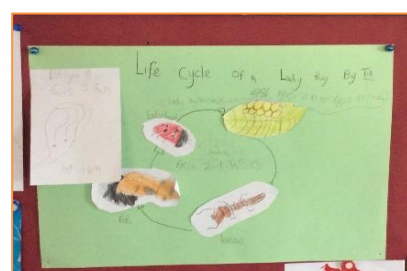
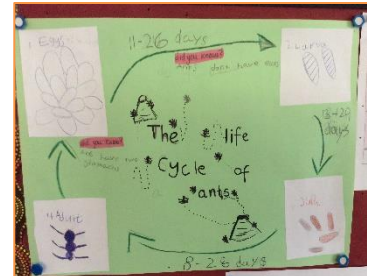


Early Childhood Class

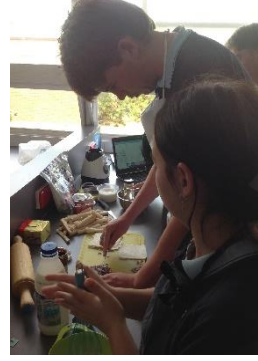
