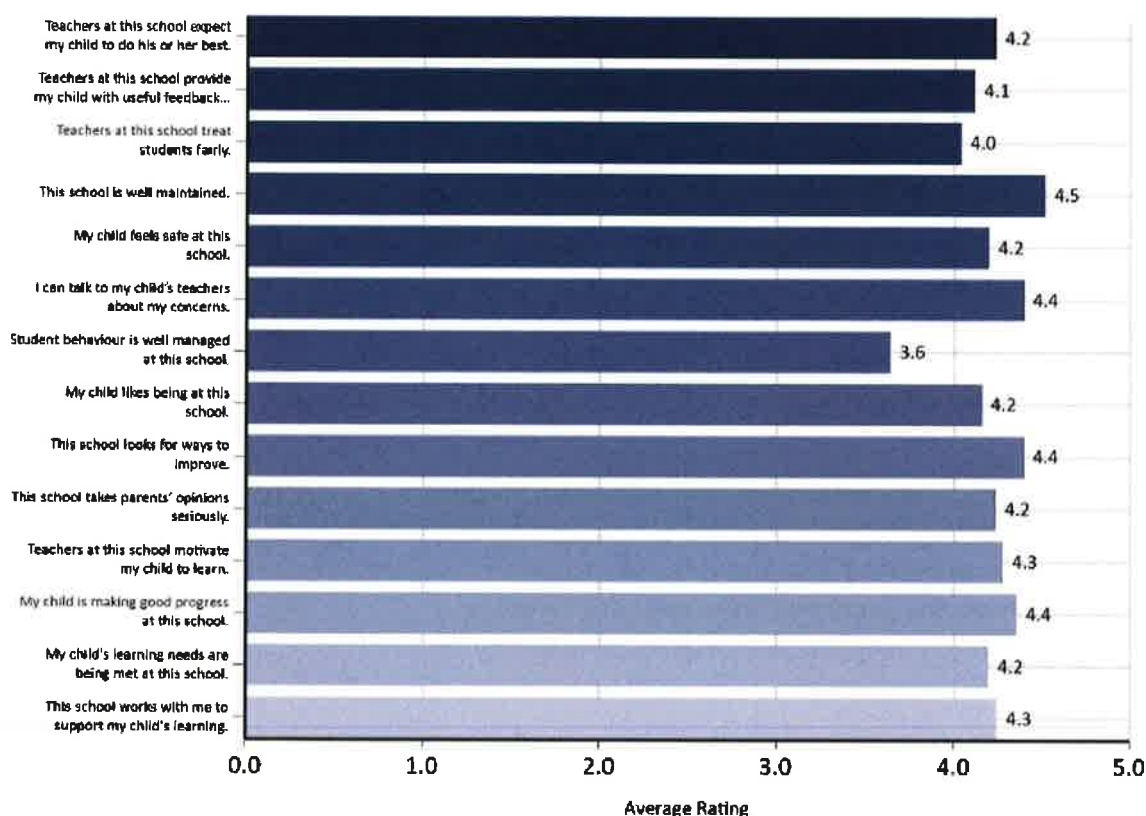


## SOUTHERN CROSS DHS PARENT SURVEY 2018

Taking printed copies in clipboards to assembly and handing to parents worked well with a wider demographic of parents completing the surveys and more Dads

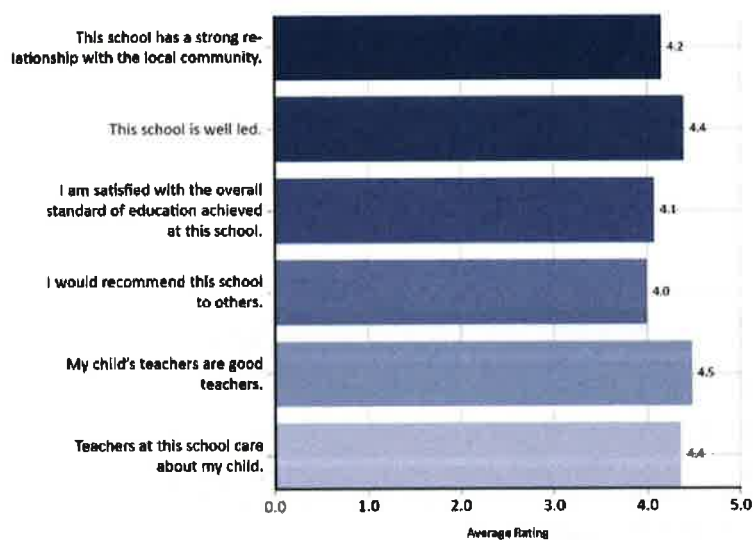
### NATIONAL PARENT QUESTIONS



Compared to 2016 results:

- Parents have assigned a higher or the same rating to 11 out of 14 areas- a fantastic result!
- Our biggest improvements were for the following categories:
  - my child is making good progress at this school (up by .4)
  - my child feels safe at this school (up by .3)
  - I can talk to my child's teachers about their concerns (up by .3)
  - my child likes being at this school (up by .3)
  - the school works with me to support my child's learning (up by .3)
- Declines were noted in the following categories:
  - teachers at this school expect my child to do his or her best (down by .3)
  - teachers at this school treat students fairly (down by .1)
  - student behaviour is well managed at this school (down by .1)

## STATE PARENT QUESTIONS



Compared to 2016 results:

- Parents have assigned a higher or the same rating to 5 out of 6 areas- a fantastic result!
- Our biggest improvement was for the following category:
  - this school has a strong relationship with the local community (up by .3)
- The only decline noted was in the following category:
  - I would recommend this school to others (down by .1)

1. Becoming an Independent Public School has been a good thing for our school.

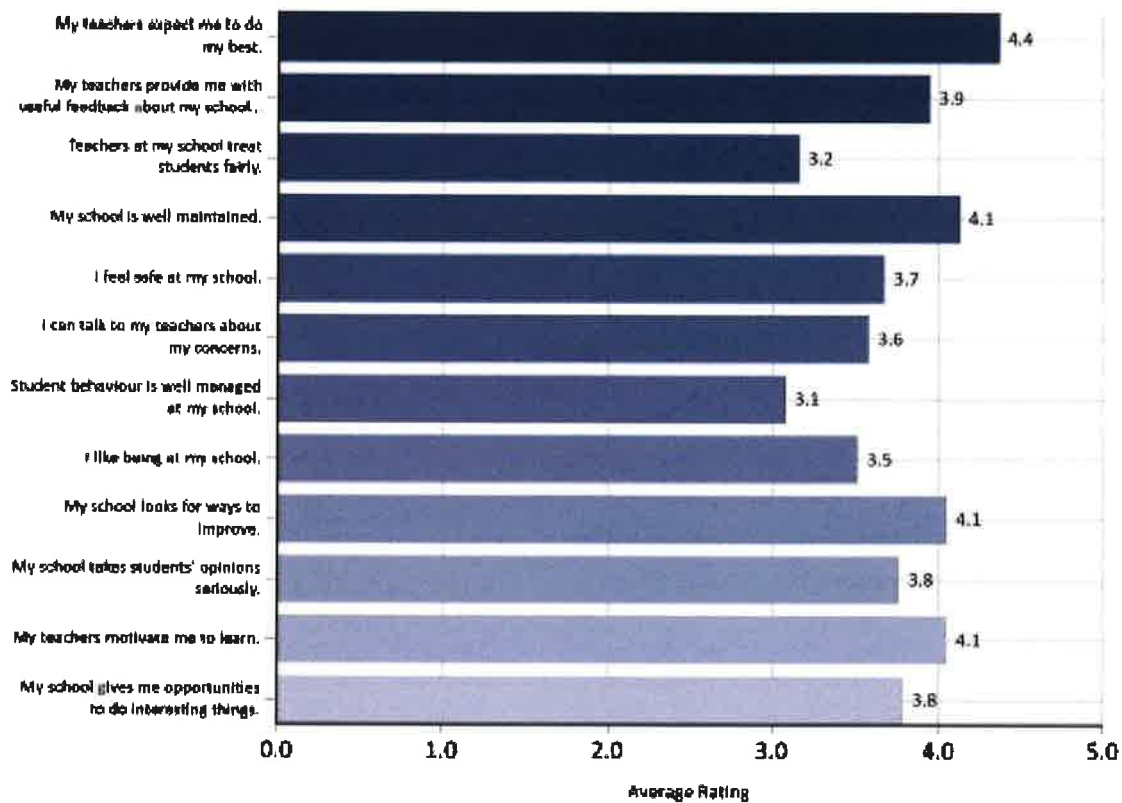
- Not one parent disagreed

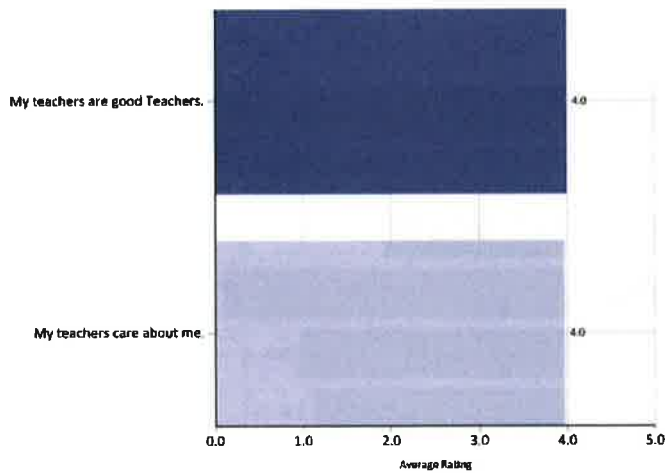
## NATIONAL STUDENT QUESTIONS



Compared to 2016 results:

- Students have assigned a higher or the same rating to 5 out of 12 areas
- Our biggest improvements were for the following categories:
  - my school is well maintained (up by .3)
  - I like being at my school (up by .2)
- Our biggest declines were noted in the following categories:
  - teachers at this school treat students fairly (down by .3)
  - my teachers expect me to do my best (down by .2)
  - my teachers motivate me to learn (down by .2)
  - I feel safe at my school (down by .2)

## STATE STUDENT QUESTIONS

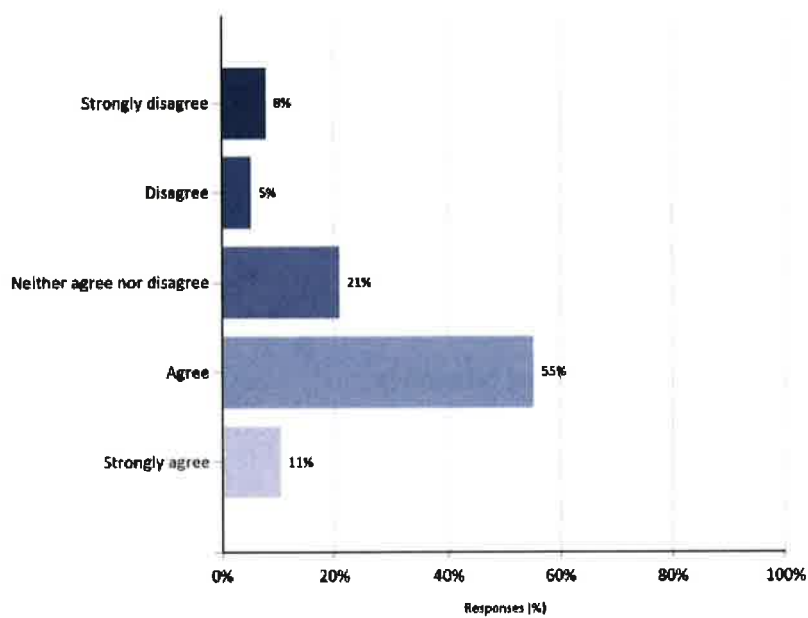


Compared to 2016 results:

- My teachers care about me (no change)

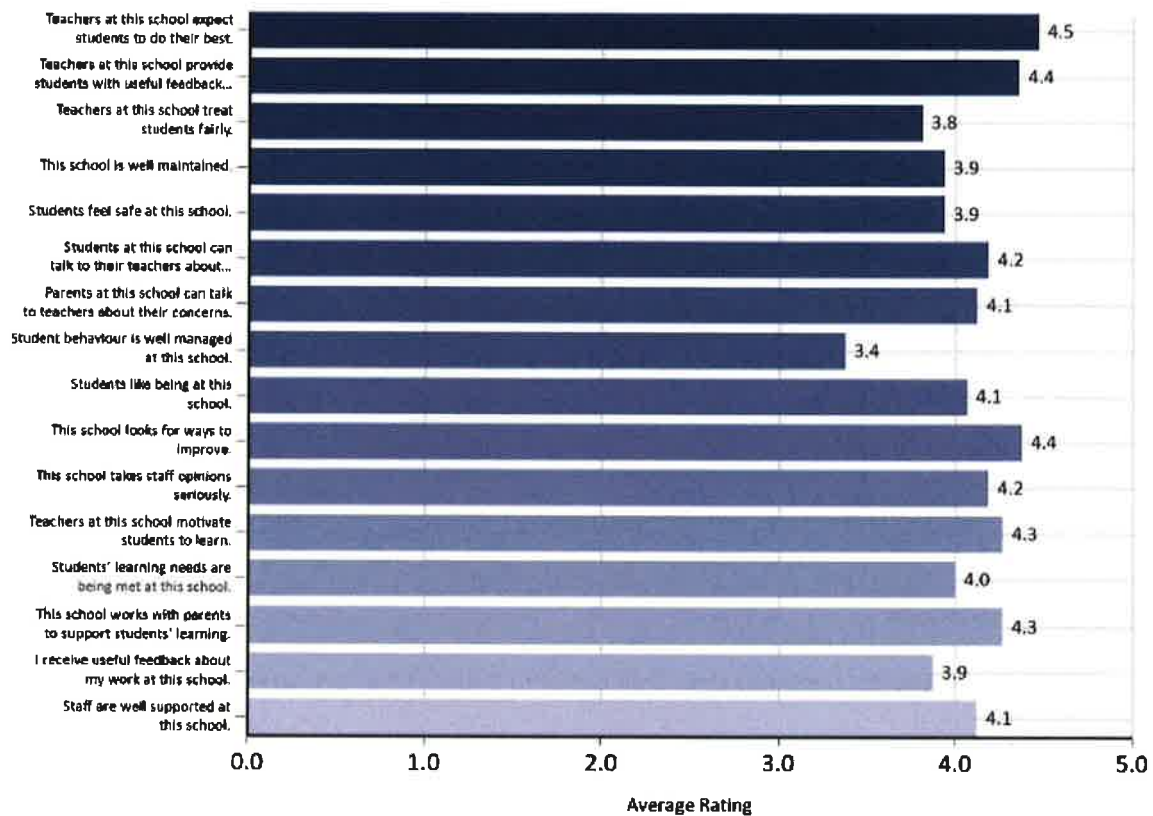
## SCHOOL QUESTION

1. Since the introduction of the Positive Behaviour Support program (PBS) there has been an improvement in behaviour at the school



With 66% of students picking agree or strongly agree and only 13% disagreeing or strongly disagreeing, most students are of the opinion that PBS has led to an improvement in behaviour at the school.

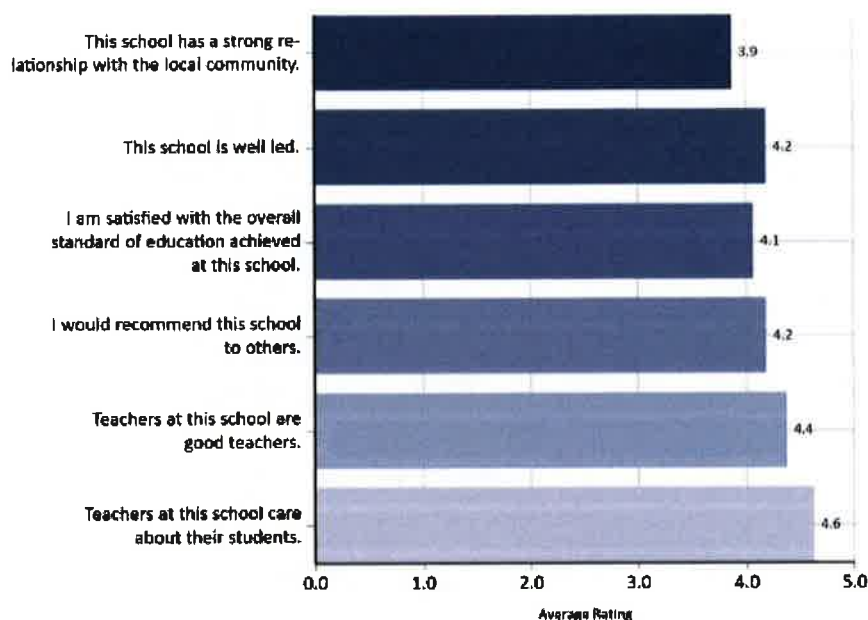
## SOUTHERN CROSS DHS STAFF SURVEY 2018



Compared to 2016 results:

- Staff have assigned a higher or the same rating to 10 out of 16 areas- a great result!
- Our biggest improvements were for the following categories:
  - students like being at this school (up by .4)
  - teachers at this school motivate students to learn (up by .4)
  - the school works with parents to support students' learning (up by .4)
  - teachers at this school provide students with useful feedback (up by .3)
- Declines were noted in the following categories:
  - student behaviour is well managed at this school (down by .5)
  - parents at this school can talk to teachers about their concerns (down by .3)
  - teachers at this school treat students fairly (down by .2)

  - I am satisfied with the overall standard of education achieved at this school (up by .3)

- 25% agreed
- 8% strongly agreed

- 50% neither agreed not disagreed
- 31% agreed
- 13% strongly agreed
